

Horse Ownership Paperwork for Roosevelt County Fair Horse Show – clarification

New Mexico Livestock Board Rules
For Transporting Horses to the Roosevelt County Fair Youth Horse Show

- Proof of ownership for in district (Curry and Roosevelt Counties)
May use one (1) of the following:
 - Horse branded with owner's permanent Brand
 - Permanent Ownership Papers from NMLB (1-H) or Temporary Form (1)
 - Registration Papers in your name
 - Bill of sale written from previous owner to you with complete horse description

The above statement is from the Roosevelt County Fair Book – Youth Horse Show stating ownership requirements by NMLB. We have additional requirements in certain situations in order to link the exhibitor to the horse if they are not the owner.

OWNERSHIP PAPERWORK in this document is what is accepted by NMLB and RCFHS. You will find definition of additional paperwork if needing to link exhibitor to horse ownership. Make sure copies are clear and complete – phone photos are not working well. If document is not on this list it is not accepted.

Definition of Use Statement as referenced in this information. This statement is necessary to link horse and exhibitor together through the required ownership paperwork where indicated.

All statements must contain:

Date entered into

Complete names of both parties

Name of horse

Statement of permission to use the horse

Description of horse to include – breed, gender, age, color, markings and brand or no brand

Relative – A simple statement as “June Snow is my niece and has my permission to use Lady Bug, sorrel Quarter horse mare with stockings on both hind legs, age 16. She has no brand.” Signed – Jane Winter

Non-relative – A simple statement as “Ben Dark has my permission to use my 12 yo bay gelding Dusk who has a white spot on his forehead. He is branded (4- on left hip.” Signed Dan Sunset

Weanling and yearling requirements

Weanlings can show on the mare's ownership paperwork as defined below.

Yearlings MUST show on their own paperwork as defined below.

The information below guides the exhibitor in creating the packet of ownership information that meets the requirements of NMLB and RCFHS.

Horse branded with owner's permanent brand

Exhibitor owns horse

NEED clear copy current brand card = done

If a non-family member owns horse

NEED clear copy current brand card + use statement from owner = done

Or if a family member owns horse

NEED clear copy current brand card + use statement from owner establishing relationship to exhibitor = done

NOTE – NMLB offers permanent or temporary ownership papers. It is your choice as to which you want to purchase.

Permanent ownership papers will establish you on the Fast Track Entry records for the fair for future competition.

Temporary ownership papers are only good to travel from your place to the fair the year they are issued. They DO NOT qualify you for Fast Track Entry.

NOTE older ownership papers will need side two copied also – current papers have all the information on one side – Be sure to check to be sure a complete copy is submitted with entry

Ownership Papers from New Mexico Livestock Board – with exhibitor as owner

NEED clear copy of ownership papers = done

Ownership Papers from New Mexico Livestock Board – non-exhibitor owner

Family member is the owner

NEED clear copy of ownership papers + use statement from owner establishing relationship to exhibitor = done

Or non-family member is the owner

NEED clear copy of ownership papers + use statement from owner = done

NOTE Make sure the copies you submit of registration papers include markings, some papers have that information on the front and others have it on the back of the document. We need it all.

Registration papers –with exhibitor as owner

NEED clear copy front and back = done

Registration papers with non-exhibitor owner

If a non-family member owns horse

NEED clear copy registration papers front/back + use statement from owner = done

Or if a family member owns horse

NEED clear copy registration papers front/back + use statement from owner establishing relationship to exhibitor = done

Registration papers with sale in progress – note that this documentation only good for the current fair – will NOT establish Fast Track entry eligibility. Will have to bring final papers the following year.

Exhibitor will be the owner

NEED clear copies of all paperwork submitted to registry = done

Or family member

NEED clear copies of all paperwork submitted to registry + statement from owner establishing relationship to exhibitor = done

Or non-family member will be the owner

NEED clear copies of all paperwork submitted to registry + statement of use from prospective owner = done

Bill of Sale or gifting statement or lease MUST contain the following information

Date of transaction

Owner – name, complete address

Buyer – name, complete address

Horse – name, breed, gender, age, brand or notation no brand, markings (scars, white, etc.)

Then

Exhibitor is the owner

NEED clear copy of bill of sale, gifting statement or lease = done

Or Family member is the owner

NEED clear copy of bill of sale, gifting statement or lease + statement from owner establishing relationship to exhibitor = done

Or Non-family member is the owner

NEED clear copy of bill of sale, gifting statement or lease + use statement from owner = done
